#### Abstract

The V.S. Pritchett papers document the life and work of British author and literary critic Victor Sawdon Pritchett (1900-1997), noted for his short stories. The collection consists of approximately 430 short stories, lectures, essays, and notebooks. The extensive correspondence includes 550 letters from V. S. Pritchett to his wife Dorothy and 140 responses from Dorothy to V.S. Pritchett. There are also approximately 1500 incoming letters to V. S. Pritchett by various authors.

## Creator History

V.S. Pritchett (1900-1997) was a British novelist, short-story writer, and literary critic renowned for his ironic style and his lively portraits of middle-class life.

He was born Victor Sawdon Pritchett in Ipswich, Suffolk, England on December 16, 1900 to Walter Sawdon Pritchett and Beatrice Helena. He left school at sixteen to work in the leather trade in London. In the 1920s he became a journalist, first during the Irish Civil War and later in Spain. Pritchett earned wide admiration for his journalism and his criticism, particularly his weekly column "Books in General" for the New Statesman in the 1950s, in which he surveyed European literature. His short stories were published in several volumes, including You Make Your Own Life (1938), Collected Stories (1956), When My Girl Comes Home (1961), The Camberwell Beauty (1974), and A Careless Widow (1989). Author of travel books, from Marching Spain (1928) to At Home and Abroad (1989), and two volumes of memoirs, A Cab at the Door (1968) and Midnight Oil (1971). Collections of his
critical essays include The Myth Makers (1979) and A Man of Letters (1985). He became President of the Society of Authors, was a foreign member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters and the Academy of Arts and Sciences, and also President of the International P.E.N. He became C.B.E in 1968, was knighted in 1975, and was made Companion of Honour in 1993. He died in London, in March 1997.

## Scope and Content Note

This 51-box collection consists of manuscripts and notebooks by V. S. Pritchett and incoming and outgoing correspondence written between 1930-1990. The manuscript collection includes numerous drafts of Pritchett's published works, from short stories to travel pieces, lectures (mostly delivered at Brandeis University in 1968 or Smith College in 1971) and radio broadcasts.
V. S. Pritchett constantly revised his works, as can be seen in his correspondence with several editors at The New Yorker advising him on story drafts. These letters not only trace extensive revisions, but illustrate a collaborative aspect of the publishing world. Another highlight is the bulky, loving correspondence between Pritchett and his wife Dorothy. While many of these were written on a near-daily basis while Pritchett traveled abroad, others date from the time when he worked for the British government during World War II. Other significant letters to Pritchett are from contemporaries such as Isaiah Berlin, David Cecil, Richard Church, D. J. Enright, Graham Greene, W. Somerset Maugham, Raymond Mortimer, Sean O'Faolain, A. D. Peters, Anthony Powell, Robert Speaight, Alain Theil, Paul Theroux, John Updike, Eudora Welty, Rebecca West, and Edmund Wilson. Unprocessed, but perhaps worthy of note, is a vast collection of newspaper and magazine clippings (from, among others, The New Yorker, The New Statesman, and The New York Review of Books) that include essays as yet unreprinted in collections of Pritchett's prose.
