The correspondence consists of letters, dating from 1907-1952, from the author to Lady Cynthia Asquith, Henry James, Alida Klemantaski Monro, Harold Monro, Edward Sackville-West, Siegfried Sassoon, Leonard Sidney Woolf, and others. Also present are letters relating to the author, dating from 1891 to 1958, between various correspondents, including Rupert Brooke, John Glasworthy, Aldous Huxley, John Masefield, Marcel Proust, and others. There are letters to the author from Lascelles Abercrombie, Maurice Baring, Edmund Charles Blunden, Gordon Bottomley, Robert Seymour Bridges, Frances Darwin Cornford, Walter D'Arcy Cressell, William Henry Davies, Walter De la Mare, John Drinkwater, James Elroy Flecker, E. M. Forster, Ronald Fuller, Mark Gertler, Wilfrid Wilson Gibson, Robert Graves, Henry James, D. H. Lawrence, John Masefield, W. S.
