Biographical Chronology

Philip Levine, 1928-

1928 Born, Detroit, Michigan January 10, of Russian immigrant parents, Harry Levine and Esther Gertrude Priscol. Second of identical twins (Brother Edward), older brother Eli.

1928-1955 Grows up in Detroit, works as a machinist and as a manual laborer, achieves formal education.

1933 Father dies.

1946-1950 Granted B. A. Degree from Wayne State University, Detroit, Michigan. Spends a good deal of time in the Miles Poetry Room, meets with fellow poets Robert Huff, Paul Petrie, Florence Goodman, William Leach, Ruby Treague, and Bernard Strepeck.

Discovers modern poetry and begins to write his own poems. Ulysses Wardlaw introduces him to the poetry of Whitman.

1951-1953 Marries Patty Kanterman.

1950-1955 Granted M. A. Degree from Wayne State University, Detroit, Michigan. Thesis on Keats's "Ode on Indolence." Leaves Detroit for good; completes degree by the mail.

1952 Receives grant for fiction study at University of Iowa Writers Workshop, rejects grant due to financial difficulties.

1953-54 Goes to University of Iowa to study with Robert Lowell. Lack of funds keeps him out of the Writing Program, but he takes a class with poet John Berryman. There he meets several students who would become lifelong friends—poets Henri Coulette, Donald Justice, Jane Cooper, and Robert Dana. The class also includes W. D. Snodgrass, Melvin Walker La Follette, Donald Petersen, Fred Block, Shirley Eliason, William Dickey, and Paul Petrie.

1954 Meets Frances J. Artley (actress and costumer, working on a teaching credential) in Iowa City, and marries her in July, in Boone, North Carolina. Adopts her son, Mark, the following year.

1954-1955 Frances teaches speech and drama at Florida State University while Levine writes and is first published in *Antioch Review*, *Beloit Poetry Journal*, *New Orleans Poetry Review*, *Poetry*, and *Western Review*.

1955 Ray B. West and Paul Engle help procure Levine a job at University of Iowa, teaching technical writing. Son John born that December. Works two years at Iowa, meeting Peter Everwine, Robert Mezey and Ted Holmes, and renews friendships with Coulette, Dana, and Peterson.

1957 Receives M. F. A. from Iowa

1957-58 Jones Fellowship at Stanford, studies with Yvor Winters.

1958 Moves to Fresno, California. Son Theodore Henri born in October.

1963 On The Edge, published by Stone Wall Press, Iowa City in a limited edition of 220.

1964 Second Press publishes a paperback trade edition of *On the Edge* 2,000 copies.

1965-1966 Lives in Barcelona, Castelldefels, Spain.

1968 Not This Pig published by Wesleyan University Press.

1968-69 Returns to Spain with family.

1970 *Five Detroits* published by Unicorn Press in a fine press, limited edition. Chosen outstanding professor at Fresno State University.

1971 Chosen outstanding professor in the California State University System. *Pili's Wall* published by Unicorn Press in a fine print limited edition. *Red Dust* published by Kayak Books.

1972 They Feed They Lion published by Atheneum.

1973 Awarded first of three National Endowment for the Arts grants in poetry.

1974 Atheneum publishes 1933. Receives first of two Guggenheim fellowships in poetry. Receives Award of Merit from the National Society of Arts and Letters. Receives the Frank O'Hara Memorial Prize.

1976 *The Names of the Lost* published by the Windhover Press (limited edition) and Atheneum (trade edition). Receives Lenore Marshall Award for *The Names of the Lost*. Cloud Marauder Press publishes *On the Edge and Over, Poems Old, Lost , and New*. Elliston Professor of Poetry at the University of Cincinnati.

1978 Visiting writer for split position at Princeton and Columbia. Returns to Columbia for a semester in 1981 and again in 1984. Writer in Residence at the National University of Australia at Canberra, New South Wales, during the summer.

1979 Atheneum publishes 7 Years from Somewhere and Ashes, which together receive the National Book Critics Circle Award. Graywolf Press publishes an edition of Ashes. Translates and publishes Tarumba, Selected Poems of Jaime Sabines, with Ernest Trejo. Visiting Writer at Vassar for February and March. Visiting writer at University of California, Berkeley.

1980 Receives The American Book Award for *Ashes*. Receives second Guggenheim Fellowship in Poetry. Visiting Writer at the University of Alabama, Birmingham.

1981-87 Teaches fall semesters at Tufts University.

1984 Teaches at New York University. *Selected Poems* published by Atheneum in the United States and by Secker and Warburg in England. Visiting Writer at Brown University. Publishes *Off the Map*, poems of the contemporary Spanish poet Gloria Fuertes, co-translated with Ada Long.

1985 Sweet Will published by Athenaeum.

1987 Receives the Ruth Lilly Poetry Prize "for distinguished poetic achievements" from Poetry and the American Council for the Arts. Receives third National Endowment for the Arts grant for poetry. Edits *The Essential Keats* for Ecco Press.

1958-87 With Peter Everwine and C. G. Hanzlicek mentors student poets Larry Levis, Lawson Inada, Glover Davis, Roberta Spear, Luis Omar Salinas, David St. John, Herbert Scott, Sherley Williams, Ernest Trejo, James Baloian, B. H. Scope and Content Note

The Philip Levine Papers contain manuscripts of his writings in a variety of stages, including notes and notebooks, manuscript drafts, typescripts, proofs and galleys. Preliminary drafts and typescripts for both published and unpublished poetry are especially numerous. A series of private journals, or diaries are included. A highlight of the papers are the 3,000 plus letters to Levine from a variety of individuals, including Edward Hirsch, Mark Jarman, Donald Hall, Garrett Hongo, Donald Justice, Larry Levis, Robert Mezey, Sharon Olds, David St. John, Gerald Stern, Mark Strand, C. K. Williams and Charles Wright. NB: Two entries contain material that extend into 1994: Manuscripts for poems published in The Simple Truth, published 1994, and the RESTRICTED journal of Dec. 1, 1993-Sept. 21, 1994.

Series Description

SERIES 1: Personal Correspondence

Correspondence arranged by incoming and outgoing, and within that alphabetically by correspondent. Personal and professional letters of Philip Levine. Incoming correspondence is more extensive and significant, including letters from informal literary advisors, other writers and friends. There are, however, long runs of correspondence to his mother, wife, and a variety of friends.
