Abstract: William Targ (1907-1999) was an American author and editor, and the publisher of Targ Editions. His wife Roslyn Targ (died 2017) was a literary agent whose clients included American novelist Henry Roth (1906-1995), known for his autobiographical works Call It Sleep and the multi-volume Mercy of a Rude Stream. The William Targ papers concerning Henry Roth, 1971-1983, contain Roth's correspondence with the Targs (13 items), and Roth's typescript early drafts of portions of Mercy of a Rude Stream, sent to William Targ for his input as editor and friend. It appears that much of the narrative corresponds to episodes in Requiem for Harlem, the fourth volume of Mercy of a Rude Stream. Roth's letters, postcards, and notes, written from Albuquerque, New Mexico chiefly to William Targ to Roth dated 1979 December 26. The collection also includes a cancelled check in payment for the typescript final draft of Call It Sleep, and two typed notes signed by William Targ, one identifying the Call It Sleep typescript, the other listing Henry Roth materials owned by Targ and his wife.

Both correspondence and typescripts comprise typed ribbon and carbon copies, bearing Roth's typed and handwritten corrections and revisions. Enclosed drafts mentioned in several letters were separated from the correspondence at an earlier date.

Targ's note (1 page), acknowledges Roth's message of December 17th, and encloses a check for \$1,000.00 from Targ Editions dated January 2, 1980. He says he will have "a nice box made for the Ms - something worthy of it." The note is accompanied by the cancelled check endorsed by Henry Roth. A typed note above his signature records full payment for the typescript of Call It Sleep.

Typescript drafts of Mercy of a Rude Stream circa 1979-circa 1981

The physical grouping of the typescript portions is based on Roth's typed book/section numbers and pagination, as found clipped together, or as previously grouped by format (xerox copies). Pages within are in the order found. The original sequence of the portions in received order can be reconstituted as folder numbers 3, 4, 6, 7, 5, 2, 8. Text is typed on one side unless noted otherwise.

- b. 1 f. 2 Book 2, Sections 8 and 9 circa 1980 July (18 leaves. Section 8 paginated 1*-11; Section 9 paginated 1-7 (re-numbered 12-18 in ink). Clipped together with an envelope postmarked July 29, 1980.)
- b. 1 f. 3 Book 2, Section 14 circa 1979-circa 1981 (6 leaves. Paginated 1, 1A, 2, 2A, 3, 4. Verso of page 1 (numbered 16) is crossed out.)
- b. 1 f. 4 Book 2, Sections 15 and 16 circa 1979-circa 1981 (28 leaves. Paginated 1-25, including two page 2s, two page 4s, two page 9s. Page 1 has "Bk2 Sec 4" in typescript, the "4" revised in red ink [to 15?]. "Bk2 Sec. 15" is typed at the top of the second page 9, "Bk2 Sec 16" on page 17.)

 Contains references to Stephen Dedalus and Ireland; possibly the "Joyce musings" mentioned in Roth's letter of March 9, 1981.
- b. 1 f. 8 Unidentified (xerox copies, 10 leaves) circa 1979-circa 1981 (Xerox copies. 10 leaves. Paginated 7, [8-10], 11-15, 15A. This portion was followed by loose envelope postmarked March 9, 1981 (removed to Correspondence).) Early draft ("Oh, my collegiate cousin....") corresponding in part to Part One, Section IX of

b. 1 f. 9 William Targ notes regarding Henry Roth materials after 1979 Typed note identifying the "final and original manuscript of Call It Sleep by Henry Roth," used for setting the book. Stamped Targ Editions and signed "Wm. Targ;" also, typed list, signed Wm. Targ, of property that William and Roslyn Targ received or purchased from Henry Roth, including the manuscript of Call It Sleep.
