She was co-author with her father of the poems in *The Reliquary* (1836), and wrote several books on Christian themes throughout her life, including: *Bible letters for children*, *The Natural history of the holy land and other places mentioned in the Bible*, *The oratory; or, The testimony of Scripture on the subject of prayer*, and *The Gospel history of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ*. (Library catalogers often confuse her with Lucy Barton, b. 1891, American costume designer.). To Messrs.
