## Pforzheimer Collection and Shelley and his Circle

The Carl H. Pforzheimer Collection of Shelley and His Circle is one of the world's leading repositories for the study of British Romanticism. Comprising over 20,000 items, the collection is conceptually centered on the life and works of the poet Percy Bysshe Shelley and his friends, relatives, and contemporaries. Formerly a part of the much larger and now dispersed Pforzheimer Library, the Pforzheimer Collection came to The New York Public Library in 1986.

### Summary

Commercially produced gilt morocco "Album Orné" scrapbook, thirty-five pages of which contain original artwork and writings, presumably by friends and acquaintances of Sir Percy Florence Shelley. Among the pieces included are: sixteen original cartoons in watercolor with manuscript captions, apparently by the same artist, three of which are signed "W. W.," two dated 1853; a watercolor of a knight attended by two boys, signed "Camilla Cary"; an ink wash drawing of a lady, crowned with laurel, with two children, signed "Mrs. Stanley Cary"; two unsigned watercolors of Middle Eastern characters; various pencil, ink and watercolor drawings of sailboats, animals, landscapes, etc.; and a manuscript poem, "Song of the Fairies," signed [J.H.T?]. Also mounted in the album is a playbill from Sir Percy's theatre at Boscombe, for a performance on 6 February 1852. With Sir Percy's bookplate, and the binder's ticket of Burn & Sons, 37 Kirby St.
