• To Martin Archer Shee, portrait painter and writer : 1 autograph letter signed : "Tuesday Morning" : (SHEE 0029a) : 2 pages (double sheet) : from Webb's Hotel : begins, "I shall be very happy to wait on you & Lady Shee on Thursday ..." Mounted in the Martin Archer Shee Autograph Album. Shelved with

manuscript volumes under "Shee.".
