· To Mr. Ramsay : 1 autograph letter signed : [w/m = 1824] : (MISC 3422) : begins, "I have just got your note & send the work according to your direction."

· To Martin Archer Shee, portrait painter and writer : 1 autograph letter signed : 1 Jul [no year] : (SHEE 0057b) : begins, "I beg you to accept my best thanks for your kind and valuable book ..." Mounted in the Martin Archer Shee Autograph Album. Shelved with bound manuscript volumes under "Shee."
