- To Leslie Preger at The Oxford Bookshop, 8 Oxford Street, Manchester: 1 autograph post card signed: 2 Mar 1946: (S'ANA 0921): from Ayot Saint Lawrence, Welwyn, Herts. (ink stamp): beneath a printed statement declaring Shaw's inability to contribute prefaces to unpublished works; body reads in

full, "I'll have a look through the typescript before I send it back; but the above is irrevocable." In 1947 Preger re-published the Avelings's Shelley's Socialism; the preface and dust-jacket of that edition include excerpts of letters from Shaw to Preger.

• To S. K. Ratcliffe, journalist: 1 autograph post card signed: 5 Jul 1922: (S'ANA 0922): from Ayot St. Lawrence, Welwyn Herts. (printed post card): begins, "Nothing doing as to Shelley, alas! He was the poet of my adolescence, and stands all by himself in my Pantheon ...".
