Scope and Content Note

- To James Knowles, Irish lexicographer : 1 autograph letter signed : 25 Jun 1830 : (MISC 4061) : from 13 Gracechurch Street; begins, "The satisfactory answer to your note of yesterday will be, I presume, the accompanying parcel with the old Admiralty Commission."
- To Basil Montagu, author and legal reformer : 1 autograph letter signed : 10 May 1830 : (MISC 0263) : from 13 Gracechurch Street; begins, "'Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh,' and, out of that abundance, addresseth those with whom it hath no claim to discourse."
