· To John Pritt Harley, actor : 4 letters : -- 1 autograph letter signed : [no date; w/m = 1815] : (B'ANA 0510) : from Pall Mall : begins, "I congratulate you on the manner in which the Trial has been conducted ..." -- 1 autograph letter signed : "1/_ past 10" [no date; pre-23 Apr 1818?] : (B'ANA 0508) : [no place] : begins, "Marie unites with me in warmest thanks for your kind support last Wednesday." -- 1 autograph letter signed : "Monday" [no date; pre 23-Apr 1818?] : (B'ANA 0509) : [no place] : begins, "We shall be happy to see you this evening to supper, if disengaged, to assist in quaffing a punch ..." -- 1 autograph

letter signed : 12 Oct 1818 : (B'ANA 0507) : from Clarges St. : begins, "Your notification of your benefit, (which I trust was such as you merited, & therefore a Bumper,) reached me when in the point of setting off for Scotland ..."; with the letter cover.

· To Sir William Rumbold : 1 autograph letter signed (carbon copy) : 5 Apr 1819 : (B'ANA (0524) : from 34 Pall Mall : begins, "It is long since I have heard of or from you ...".
