• To J. H. Ryland Esq. at the Mechanics' Institute, Bradford, Yorkshire : 1 autograph envelope : 5 Oct 1847 : (MISC 4023.03a) : Knight's hand and the date identified in ink in an unknown hand. Mounted in the Mary Ann Humble Autograph Album. Shelved with oversized manuscript volumes.

 \cdot To an unknown correspondent : 1 autograph inscription signed : 25 Feb 1857 : (MISC 3477b) : in ink on a sheet of stationery paper; begins, "With the respectful Compts of ...".
