L." Letter cover bears Montgomery's monogram wax seal. Apparently given to Abraham Hayward as an autograph specimen. Within the Abraham Hayward correspondence files.

Apparently given to Abraham Hayward as an autograph specimen. Within the Abraham Hayward correspondence files.

· To [Sir John Bowring?] : 1 autograph letter signed : [no date] : (MISC 4023.38c) : from 18 St James Square : begins, "I am so pressed with engagements that I cannot fix a time for the S. J. ..." Mounted within the Mary Ann Humble autograph album. Shelved with oversized manuscript volumes.
