R."; the hand is unidentified. -- 1 autograph letter signed: 14 Jun 1804: (G'ANA 0013): from Hatfield Place, near Bath: begins, "Since I wrote to inform you that I had drawn on you for one hundred & fifty pounds, from the 28th of May, I have met with a disappointment of an equal sum ...".
