· To the Rev. Thomas Maude, clergyman and minor poet : 4 items : -- 1 autograph letter signed : 27 Apr 1827 : (MISC 1580) : 3 pages (double sheet) : [from Ross, Herefordshire] : begins, "My son has sent

me down to Ross on my Herefordshire journey . . . ." -- 1 autograph letter signed : 26 Mar 1828 : (MISC 1581) : 1 page (double sheet) : from 32 Red Lion Sq : begins, "Having been out of town I cd not thank you earlier for your little poem . . ."; with an autograph notation signed by Maude on page 3 of the letter sheet. -- 1 autograph letter signed : 13 May 1830 : (MISC 1582) : 3 pages (double sheet) : from Winchmore Hill : begins, "I am not certain that Mr. D'Israeli is at present in London . . ."; with a brief notation by Maude, signed "TM," at the foot of page 1. -- 1 autograph letter signed : 25 Nov 1832 : (MISC 1583) : 2 1/\_ pages (double sheet) : from Winchmore Hill : begins, "I thank you for your note. I had all Skelton's works before me -- but only quoted a few passages . . .".
