- To John Harris, of Harris & Pearse, framemakers: 1 autograph letter signed: 12/24 [i.e., 24] Aug 1823: (MISC 2577): 1 page (double sheet): from St. Petersburg: begins, "Will you be good enough to deliver to my friend Sir James Stuart or to any one he may send with a with a written order I have forwarded to him the sketches you have of mine of the Seige [sic] of Acre.".
- To Edward Magrath, secretary of the Athenaeum Club: 1 autograph letter signed: 21 Aug 1830: (MISC 2576): 2 pages (double sheet): from Caracas: begins, "I have already acknowledges to you

officially (in the accompanying letter) my elation as a member of the Athenaeum ".

- To Elias Mocatta, merchant : 1 autograph letter signed : 3 Apr 1830 : (MISC 2697) : 2 1/_ pages (double sheet) : from Foreign Office : begins, "I have to acknowledge the receipt of your note of the 26th ".
- To Martin Archer Shee, portrait painter and writer: 1 autograph letter signed: 18 Sep 1832: (SHEE 0034): 1 \(^1/_\) pages (double sheet): from Caracas: begins, "Allow me to most cordially recommend to your protection and attention, my young friend Mr Henry Woods...." Mounted in the Martin Archer Shee autograph album.
