Abstract

Between 1837 and 1844, inventor Alfred Lewis Vail worked together with Samuel F.B. Morse in the development and spread of the telegraph. In 1848, Vail moved to his home town, Morristown, New Jersey, and spent the last ten years of his life conducting genealogical research.

The collection contains correspondence, research notes and notebooks, questionnaires completed by family members, and family charts on the Vail family, compiled by Alfred Vail. Accompanying card file compiled by Henry Vail, ca. 1902, is an index to the correspondence and research notes in the 20 bound volumes in Boxes 1-11.
