Scope and content note

This collection contains booklets, brochures, maps, pamphlets, postcards, kits, clippings, and souvenir photographs, primarily of the United States, but also a number of materials on Canada and several other countries. New York City, New York State and Virginia have the largest number of materials, including some for the New York 1939 World's Fair and the 1964 World's Fair. Among the subjects in the collection are Abraham Lincoln, national parks, Native Americans, and the American Civil War.
