Title: The vindication of astrology &c

Abstract: Manuscript written in England in 1674 by an unknown author, divided into chapters which respond to criticisms and alleged misunderstandings of astrology. Contains many Biblical allusions and argues that astrology is not witchcraft. Includes "An Appendix Containing a Vindication of Physick, Chiromancy, and Physiognomy" as well as an index which lists the chapter titles
