**Abstract:** This manuscript notebook contains notes on atmospherics, winds, storms, balloon observations, gases, and other topics, with entries beginning on September 15, 1905 and continuing through at least 1907. Its author is unknown, although several names or other inscriptions are written on the volume, including "the analyst Walter J. Sykes, 16 James Street, Haymarket, London" and "U.S. Chief of Weather Bureau, Washington D.C." Entries often include calculations or illustrations
