Description The socialist, journalist, and biographer, David Fulton Karsner, was born in Baltimorc in 1889, and died in New York City in 1941. H,s career as a newspaperman began in Chicago where he became friendly with Jack London and Carl Sandburg. In 1911 he returned to the east and worked on newspapers in Philadelphia and New York City and later became managing editor of the socialist New York Call.. At this time he became a close associate of the socialist leader and presidential candidate, Eugene V. Debs. In 1919 he wrote Debs: His Authorized Life and Letters, and, Debs Goes to Prison; and in 1922, Talks with Debs in Terre Hautew which was about Debs's imprisonment for treason in 1919. Karsner also wrote biographies of Andrew Jackson, and the millionaire, H. Tabot. At the time of his death Karsner was employed as a copyreader by the New York Post.

The papers consist of correspondence, 1912-1929, with Eugene V. Debs, his borther, Theorem Debs, and his wife, Kathryn M. Debs, and others, including, Theodore Dreiser, relating to socialist issues, the trial and imprisonment for treason of Eugene V, Debs. There also are somewritings by Debs and Karsner, : papers relative to Debs's imprisonment, and photographs of Eugene Debs.
