Abstract: Charles P. Staubach (1870-1966) worked as a sales executive for

the Burroughs Corporation, served as an officer in the 8th Infantry Regiment, New York National Guard, and was the first president of the Century Road Club Association. The Charles P. Staubach family history notebooks, compiled by Staubach from 1933-1955 and continued by his sons, 1966-1977, concern the history of his and his wife's families across multiple generations. The collection contains genealogical and biographical information on his parents, Baldwin Staubach and Elise Schwab, his wife Edith Arnold's parents, George Arnold and Frances Dubois, and numerous allied families. The notebooks also contain Staubach's memoir of his life and career, and serve as a scrapbook of family records including birth and death certificates, correspondence, pedigrees, photographs, clippings,

maps, ephemera, and research notes.

RESOLUTE of the Hamburg-American Line, which left New York City on January 6, 1930, crossing the Atlantic and visiting Madeira, Gibraltar, and the Mediterranean, including Athens, Greece..

Biographical note

Charles P. Staubach (1870-1966) was a sales executive for the Burroughs Corporation who researched the history and genealogy of his family. He was born in 1870 in Fishkill, N.Y. and moved with his family to New York City in 1880. He worked in his family's iron foundry and machine business until it was liquidated in 1884, and graduated from City College in 1887. Staubach served as an officer in the 8th Infantry Regiment of the New York National Guard. An avid cyclist, Staubach was a founder and first president of the Century Road Club Association, a bicycle racing club based in New York City. He worked as a general sales manager for the Burroughs Corporation from 1906 until his retirement in 1929, serving branch offices in Hartford, CT and Newark, NJ. Staubach married Edith Arnold (1871-1945) in 1897 and the couple had three sons, Charles, Arnold, and Lodge, and a daughter Elsie. He died in 1966 at the age of 95.

Scope and content note

The Charles P. Staubach family history notebooks, compiled by Staubach from 1933-1955 and edited and augmented by his sons, 1966-1977, concern the history of his and his wife's family across multiple generations. The collection contains genealogical and biographical information on his parents, Baldwin Staubach and Elise Schwab, his wife Edith Arnold's parents, George Arnold and Frances Dubois, and numerous allied families. The notebooks also contain Staubach's memoir of his life and career, and serve as a scrapbook of family records including birth and death certificates, correspondence, pedigrees, photographs, clippings, maps, ephemera, and research notes.

Notable materials include Charles and Edith Staubach's marriage vow booklet, photographic portraits of Staubach as an award-winning cyclist, and a narrative account of his father Baldwin Staubach that traces his emigration in 1857 from Germany to the village of Fishkill in Dutchess County, N.Y., marking his ascent from a sewing machine salesman to the proprietor of a successful iron foundry and machine shop business in 1880. Other items of interest include pages from an 18th century family bible, sales catalogs from Baldwin Staubach's iron foundry and machine business, some correspondence and notes regarding the family burial plot in Tarrytown, N.Y., 1945-1963, and supplemental material added by Staubach's sons, 1966-1974 including obituaries of their father and related memorial materials. Originally found in a six notebook binders, the contents have been rehoused and boxed in their original order. Series and folder titles reflect the original volume titles and chapter headings.
