Biographical note

The Mitchell family was descended from William and Margaret Mitchell of Coleraine, Northern Ireland. They had three sons, William, John and Edward (1769-1834). Their father, a bookmaker and stationer, died in 1773 and their mother was remarried in 1779, to John Fulton William and Edward immigrated to America around 1790. The two brothers set up a business as bookbinders in Philadelphia and then in New York. William later moved to Philadelphia, where he worked as a bookbinder and on the newspaper, The Porcupine's Gazette and died in 1798. Edward stayed in New York and married Cornelia Anderson in 1794. In 1801 he became a member of the Methodist Church and in 1803 he was ordained as a minister in the Society of United Christian Friends. He was active in this profession, until his death in 1834, writing and preaching many sermons and publishing a collection called *The Christian Universalist*. Mitchell had eight children, including William Mitchell, an attorney and Judge who served on the Supreme Court of the State of New York. William married Mary Penfold Berrien (daughter of Cornelius Penfold Berrien and Elizabeth Bruen Morris). One of their sons, Cornelius Berrien Mitchell served in the Civil War. He joined the Anthon Battalion Light Artillery in 1862 and joined the 84th Regiment of the National Guard of the State of New York in 1863. filling the ranks of Adjutant, Lieutenant Colonel, Inspector of Rifle Practice, Chief of Artillery and Colonel before resigning in 1882. He was also a merchant and an active member of many civic and religious organizations. In 1880 he married Mary Elizabeth Davis and he was the father of Cornelius von Erden Mitchell.

Henry Spingler was a New York merchant gardener, who purchased a 22-acre plot of land in lower Manhattan in 1762 from Elias Brevoort, a large portion of which has subsequently been transformed into Union Square Park. His name is on the Spingler Building, which stands on the site of the Spingler House hotel at 5-9 Union Square West, though most of this land was eventually sold back to the City. The site was also home to a prestigious school for girls in the nineteenth century, the Spingler Institute. Henry Spingler's daughter, Eliza M. Spingler Fonerden (who was married to Lieutenant James Fonerden, the son of Adam Fonerden an abolitionist from Baltimore, MD) selected a plot of this land to live on, and had a house built on it, which became the mansion at 21 West 14th Street, where descendants of the family continued to live for generations. Their daughter, Mary Spingler Fonerden married Michael Murray Van Beuren, who was later a Colonel in the in 11th Regiment of the Washington Guard and also managed his wife's property. Their daughter, Mary Louise Van Beuren married Captain John W. Davis, who was the son of Dr. John Davis. Their daughter, Mary Elizabeth Davis, married Cornelius Berrien Mitchell and was the mother of Cornelius von Erden Mitchell.

Scope and content note

The Mitchell Family Papers consist of materials collected by Cornelius von Erden Mitchell, (1883-1966), author of *Ancestry of William Spingler Mitchell, Cornelius von Erden Mitchell, John Van Beuren Mitchell*, which had belonged to his ancestors. In additional to the Mitchell family, there is material in this collection from the Abbott, Anderson, Banks, Beach, Berrien, Brevoort, Davis, Fonerden (von Erden), Leverich, Lyon, Morris, Prescott, Reynolds, Rogers, Spingler, Van Beuren and Warde families.

The materials in this collection include account books (1785-1836) belonging to Henry Spingler of New York, personal correspondence between the members of the families, particularly Rev. Edward Mitchell (1769-1834) and his son, the Hon. William Mitchell (1801-1886), professional correspondence, indenture documents, legal documents, certificates, copies of sixteenth and eighteenth century wills, family trees, ancestral charts and lists of pedigree of various members of the families. Also included are military documents (1800-1876), such as regimental orders, correspondence and certificates of Col. Michael M. Van Beuren, Major John Berrien, Hon. William Mitchell and Cornelius Berrien Mitchell as well as photographs (small, large and oversized) and daguerreotypes (1848-1927) of members of the families, particularly of the Davis, Mitchell and Van Beuren families, and their residences in Connecticut, New Jersey and New York, sermons and other religious writings (1810-1834,) by Rev. Edward Mitchell, scrapbooks (1875-1925) kept by Cornelius Berrien Mitchell and John W. A. Davis, and a nineteenth century map and newspaper from Coleraine, Ireland, where the Mitchells came from.

This series includes the papers of members of the Mitchell family from 1793-1940. Items from Rev. Edward Mitchell include personal correspondence (1794-1833), sermons and other writings (1810-1834) as well as business papers and legal documents. Items from his son the NY State Supreme Court judge, William Mitchell include, legal documents, photographs, certificates of his professional appointments and regimental orders. Items from Cornelius Berrien Mitchell include military documents (1862-1876), correspondence, clippings and a scrapbook on rifle associations (1874-1875). Materials on other members of the Mitchell family include photographs, daguerreotypes, correspondence, maps, indenture documents and family trees.

Series II: Davis Family, 1825-1940

This series mainly consists of correspondence, legal documents, diaries, photographs and daguerreotypes of members of the Davis family, such as Dr. John Davis, John W. Davis, John W. A. Davis, Mary Louise Van Beuren Davis and Michael Van Beuren. This series also includes a certificate of John W. Davis' letters written home while he was serving in the Civil War, his engagement diaries (1851-1883), his 1865 admission to the Supreme Court of the State of New York. Also included are the marriage certificate and various other early/mid nineteenth century legal documents of Dr. John Davis and a scrapbook kept by John W. A. Davis containing clipping on the David and Van Beuren families (1880-1925.)

Series IV: Van Beuren Family, 1799-1947

This series consists of legal documents, personal papers and photographs and daguerreotypes of members of the Van Beuren family, such as Elizabeth Van Beuren, Josephine Van Beuren, Mary Spingler Van Beuren, Mary Spingler Fonerden Van Beuren and Col. Michael Murray Van Beuren. Also included is an account book (1799-1806), which belonged to Egbert Van Beuren of Charleston and military documents of Michael M. Van Beuren, who was a Colonel in the Washington Guard, 11th Regiment and his son Michael Murray Van Beuren, who server in the New York State Infantry. A highlight of this series is the original and a typed transcript of a diary kept by Mary Spingler Fonerden (who later married Michael Van Beuren), 1827-1828, which provides a look into the daily life of a wealthy 17-year old girl in nineteenth century New York..
