Abstract: Robert McCord (1863-1946) was a graduate of Peekskill Military Academy and an attorney who practiced law for fifty years in Westchester County, New York. He pursued the McCord family genealogy as a pastime, tracing the family lineage back to his great-great grandfather James McCord who emigrated from Scotland to the Province of New York in 1732.
