Abstract: Richard Montgomery Hasbrouck (1776-1860) was a merchant from Kingston, New York. With his wife, Maria Johnson, Hasbrouck had ten children, including son John Whitbeck Hasbrouck, a Whig party politician and activist. The Hasbrouck family descended from brothers Jean and Abraham Hasbrouck, French Huguenots who arrived in New Paltz, New York in the 1670s
