Abstract: The collection consists of an account book belonging to an unidentified merchant in Westchester County, New York dating from 1802-1805. The account records transactions relating to molasses, leather goods, vegetables, dry goods, and other sundries. Surnames frequently mentioned in the accounts include Van Wart, Field, Leonard, Birdsall, Brundage, Merritt, Stivers, Clapp, Fox, Wilkins, Burling, Farrington, and Knapps
