Records include articles of association, proceedings, a roll of members, and accounts of the Society, which was one of the earliest mutual or local cooperative insurance societies. The volume also contains the accounts of John Minot Moody, a shipbuilder who lived in Bath. Moody's account entries concern the Pejepscott Right, shipbuilding, and family accounts; these entries date from 1820 to 1844
