abortion laws were successfully challenged on constitutional grounds, NARAL's name was
changed to the National Abortion Rights Action League, and its purpose became the as-
surance of the "right to a safe, legal abortion for all women."
The records are an extensive collection of news clippings concerning
the abortion issue (1970-1973). The are arranged geographically (including most states
and a few foreign countries), and they mention local events, legislative action, and
editorial opinion on the issue.
