Mr. Murphy, "who abjured his errors in John St. Catholic Church," with remarks by W.J. Battersby. Also includes "The Third Reformation in Ireland" in a manuscript letter to the Most Rev. Dr. [William] Magee, Protestant Archbishop of Dublin by Battersby, published in England and Ireland, 1828
