Abstract: The "D.M.T: An Hallucinatory Bead Game" broadside was created by Jackie Cassen, Ralph Metzner, and Mary McKay, probably around 1966. The broadside has a short, typewritten text that gives a mystical, metaphorical description of a "strange journey" achieved through the use of DMT (Dimethyltryptamine). The bottom of the broadside states, "For Timothy Leary."
