BIOGRAPHY

Julius Ensign Rockwell (1860-1926), stenographer for the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Education and, bibliographer, Published works include: <u>The Teaching Practice Literature of Shorthand</u> (1884); <u>Short-hand Instruction and Practice</u> (1893).

The <u>Guide to the Research Collection of the New York Public Library</u> (1975) states that Rockwell collected particular distinctive curious, or rare titles, rather than systematic series of editions; these include textbooks, Bibles, Testaments and prayer books in the various systems of shorthand. The manuscript portion of this collection is in the Manuscript Section of the Rare Books and Manuscripts Division. The National Shorthand Reporters Association donated this collection to the library in 1927.

DESCRIPTION

The collection, 1762-1882, contain incoming letters to Rockwell, writings and printed matter by other shorthand writers.

The letters, 1884-1924, written in longhand are from shorthand writers and teachers on the subject of shorthand. The writings are: <u>Stenography</u> <u>or Shorthand. Writing Made Easy</u> by Charles Dundas (1817); <u>Criticisms</u> <u>on the New Testament</u> by J.D. Scotland (?), and, <u>System of Shorthand</u> (1775). Printed Matter: <u>Howells</u>, <u>Acme System of Phonography</u> (1921); <u>The Reporters</u> <u>Manual and Vocabulary</u> by Benn Pitman and R.P. Prosser (1884); <u>Manual of</u> Phonography (1860); <u>The Reporters Companion</u> (1877) by Benn Pitman.

Recent additions to the collection are shorthand manuscripts; <u>Bible</u>. <u>New Testament</u>. <u>English Shorthand</u> (188-?; 1818); <u>Bible</u>. <u>Old Testament</u>. <u>Psalms</u>. <u>English Shorthand</u>.
