Papers, ca. 1828-1963**

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Summary

- Title: Serrell-Opdycke-Patrick Papers, c1828-1963
- Size: 16 lin. ft. (32 AB; 5 flat boxes; 1 vol.)
- Source: Gift of Dorothy L. Patrick (via Map Division)
- Access: Engineering drawings by James E. Serrell which must undergo conservation treatment before research use.
- Description: Over one-half of the papers consists of New York City land maps and surveys (with collateral papers) made by James E. Serrell (1820-1892), Henry G. Opdycke (1870-1938), the firm of Opdycke and Thomson, and by William R. Patrick, all of whom were city surveyors and civil engineers. The remainder of the papers consists of personal papers of James E. Serrell, Henry G. Opdycke, and William R. Patrick relating mainly to their professional careers.

Biographical Note

-James E. Serrell-

James E. Serrell (1820-92), surveyor and civil engineer, was the son of William and Anne Serrell. He appears to have been privately educated and may have assisted in the training of his distinguished brother, Edward Wellman Serrell (1826-), civil engineer and soldier, who reportedly received his professional education "under the direction of an elder brother."

In 1845 at age 25 Serrell was appointed city surveyor in the Street Department of New York City. During the following four decades he carried on a flourishing surveying practice in New York City executing numerous land surveys, maps and engineering studies for his private, public and institutional clients. As city surveyor Serrell prepared maps, surveys, and estimates for the grading and paving of city streets, the setting of curbs and gutters, the construction of culverts and sewers, and other improvements. He also prepared assessment lists of property owners for city tax purposes.

Throughout much of his career Serrell carried on experiments for improvements in the design of marine engines and propellers. He also advised on improving the design of the reflecting apparatus in lighthouses.

At the outbreak of the Civil War Serrell held the rank of captain in the corps of engineers of the 11th Regiment of the New York State Militia. He does not appear, however, to have taken an active part in the war.

Serrell had (at least) two sons, James E. Serrell, Jr. (1846-73), and Robert A. Serrell (b. 1860). An elder brother, John J. Serrell, was also a surveyor and civil engineer.

-Henry G. Opdycke-

Henry G. Opdycke (1870-1938), civil engineer and city surveyor, was born in Philadelphia, the son of Dr. Washington Opdycke and Mary Jane (Abernathy) Opdycke. His parents were descended from original Dutch settlers in New York. As an engineer practicing in New York City Opdycke specialized in problems relating to vibrations in buildings and other structures caused by construction activities. He served as a consulting engineer during the construction of New York City's first subway and for its 7th Avenue line. He also fixed the coordinates for the building of Pennsylvania Station and the base line for Grand Central Station.

Opdycke began his professional career in New York about 1893 as a principal assistant and city surveyor in the Lawyer's Engineering and Surveying Company. In 1899 he and his colleague, H. Serrell Thomson, who was also employed by the same company, formed a partnership, Opdycke & Thomson, City Surveyors and Civil Engineers, which was dissolved in April of 1905. Opdycke, however, continued his surveying practice and in later years became associated with William R. Patrick who was also a city surveyor and civil engineer.

For use in its surveying work the firm of Opdycke & Thomson acquired the "complete surveying plant" (including maps, surveys, and field notebooks) of James E. Serrell, C.E. who was appointed city surveyor in 1845. The "plant" which was acquired from the administratrix of Serrell's Estate, was eventually purchased by Opdycke for the sum of \$50. The firm also had access to the "plant" of John J. Serrell, C.E. who was appointed city surveyor in 1837.

Opdycke was member of the American Society of Civil Engineers. During the early 1900's he was a consulting engineer for the American Automobile Association and the Automobile Club of America. During W.W.I. Opdycke served with the A.E.F. in France as a signal officer with the rank of major. At his death he was survived by his widow, Ida Louise (Stryker) Opdycke, and a son, Barclay Opdycke.

-William R. Patrick-

William R. Patrick was a civil engineer and city surveyor who practiced in New York City. By 1919 he had become associated with Henry G. Opdycke in the latter's surveying and engineering work. Patrick eventually assumed Opdycke's surveying business taking possession of Opdycke's papers and the papers of James E. Serrell.

Scope and Content Note

The Serrell-Opdycke-Patrick Papers document the evolution of property ownership and land use in New York City and the development of the city's urban infrastructure of streets and sewers especially during the latter half of the 19th century (1840's-1890's). Over one-half of the collection consists of New York City land maps and surveys arranged by city block number with collateral papers including correspondence, engineering notes and field notebooks. The papers reflect the surveying and engineering work of James E. Serrell (1820-92), Henry G. Opdycke (1870-1938), the firm of Opdycke & Thomson, and (to a lesser extent) of William R. Patrick, all of whom were city surveyors and civil engineers practicing in New York City. Included also are personal and miscellaneous papers of James E. Serrell, Henry G. Opdycke, and (to a lesser extent) of William R. Patrick relating mainly to their professional careers.

Provenance Note

The Serrell-Opdycke-Patrick Papers were donated to the Library's Map Division in October of 1994 by Dorothy L. Patrick, daughter of William R. Patrick. The papers were subsequently transferred from the Map Division to the Manuscripts & Archives Section.

Arrangement Note

The papers are arranged into five series: I. New York City Land Maps and Surveys; II. Papers of James E. Serrell; III. Papers of Henry G. Opdycke; IV. Papers of William R. Patrick; and V. Oversized Maps and Papers. The series are described in sequence below.

Series Descriptions

Series I. New York City Land Maps and Surveys (Containers #1-13)

The bulk of the land maps and surveys, which are arranged by block number and which are described on the Checklist of Land Maps and Surveys (see: pp. 12-41 of this inventory) fall in the period from the 1840's to 1911. The bulk of the maps and surveys dated prior to 1892 were executed by James E. Serrell, city surveyor and civil engineer, who was employed by the Street Department of New York City and who also conducted his own private practice as a surveyor and civil engineer. The bulk of the maps and surveys dated between 1892 and 1905 were executed by Henry G. Opdycke and H. Serrell Thomson who were partners in the firm of Opdycke & Thomson, city surveyors and civil engineers. The firm acquired James E. Serrell's original maps, notes and surveys which they utilized in their own professional work. The bulk of the maps and surveys dated after March of 1905 (when the partnership was dissolved) were executed by Henry G. Opdycke. There are also a few maps and surveys (in the later period) executed by William R. Patrick who was also a surveyor and civil engineer.

Filed with the maps and surveys especially in the earlier period (prior to 1892) are a variety of other papers including correspondence, notes, requests for surveys, copies of deeds; copies of court transcripts (involving litigation in which James E. Serrell appeared as an expert witness); assessment lists for street improvements (grading, paving, flagging, setting curbs and gutters), and for the building of sewers; and printed broadsides of auction sales. The correspondence (which includes a few copies of replies by Serrell) relates mainly to requests for maps and surveys from attorneys, landowners, architects, builders, merchants, realtors, and insurance companies.

The maps and surveys executed by James E. Serrell include pen and ink drawings, frequently multicolored, on paper and on linen. Those executed by Opdycke & Thomson, by Henry G. Opdycke and by William R. Patrick are in the form of drafts on tissue paper and final blueprint drawings.

Many of the maps and surveys executed by Serrell are keyed to his field notebooks by an annotation in the form of "B" followed by a number (e.g., "B-30" indicating field notebook #30).

The maps and surveys are for streets, lots, and buildings in the Boroughs of Manhattan and the Bronx. Included are vault surveys, excavation surveys, possession surveys, and architects' surveys.

Series II. Papers of James E. Serrell (Containers #20-27)

The papers (1845?-1892) of James E. Serrell consist of:

- A. Field Notebooks of Land Surveys; and
- B. Correspondence, Land and Miscellaneous Papers.

A. The field notebooks (1845-80) kept by Serrell consist of 84 notebooks (including one blank book) arranged chronologically and numbered (with evident gaps in the serial order) from 1 to 136. There are no field notebooks for the periods Nov. 1854 - March 1860; and May 1877 - May 1880. The internal arrangement of the notebooks is chronological as in a diary. The notebooks record Serrell's daily surveying activities mainly in New York City for his private clients and for the City of New York. The notes, which are mainly in pencil, include the name and address of the client or property owner, the location of the area surveyed, a rough sketch or diagram (annotated with numerous calculations) of the area surveyed and the amount billed (or paid) for the survey. Included also are engineering notes and estimates for the construction of sewers, for earth and rock excavations, for the laying out of curbs, gutters, culverts, and drains, and for the flagging, grading and paving of city streets. There are also a few assessment lists for sewers prepared by Serrell for city tax purposes.

Serrell's private clients include property owners, merchants, attorneys, builders and architects. His private clients included Henry Brevoort, Peter Goelet, John Jay, John Lafarge, Allan Melville, Moses B. Taylor, James E. Shaw, Alexander T. Stewart, William R. Stewart, Cornelius Vanderbilt, and Isaac Walton. His commercial and institutional clients included the Board of Education, Booth's Theater, Brown Brothers, Crystal Palace, Croton Aqueduct Department, Dry Dock Bank, Eighth Avenue Rail Road Co., Fulton Rail Road Co., the Hippodrome, Metropolitan Gas Works, Mott Haven Canal, New York Stock Exchange, New York State Arsenal, Novelty Iron Works, Roosevelt Hospital, Sixth Avenue Rail Road, Tammany Hall, Trinity Church, and Western Union Telegraph.

There are also a few surveys of lands and properties outside of New York City proper including Brooklyn, Englewood (New Jersey), Glen Cove (Long Island), Mott Haven (Westchester Co.), Randall's Island, Stapleton, (Staten Island), and Ward's Island.

Interspersed in the field notes, especially in the earlier period, are brief personal notes and observations relating to the weather and to his comings and goings. Included are notes relating to an invention of an "exhausting engine" (Books #28, #30), a boat engine (Book #72), and a "propeller" "or mode of propelling vessels" (Book #80). Serrell also devised a plan for red reflectors for light houses. In 1849 he observed the lighting of the lamps at the lighthouse at Execution Rocks (off Sands Point, Long Island) and made recommendations for improvements in its lighting mechanism (Books #8 and #10). Miscellaneous entries during the Civil War period mention the readiness of his regiment to go to war (Book #69), the N.Y.C. Draft Riots, assassination of President Lincoln, and the embarkment of a naval expedition from Fortress Monroe which included his brother Edward W. Serrell, then colonel of an engineering regiment.

While on a Jersey City ferry Serrell also mentions seeing the iron plated vessel "Weehawken". A sketch of the vessel follows the entry (Book #73).

A cabinet photographic portrait of James E. Serrell taken in January of 1876 when he was 56 years old is pasted on the back inside cover of Book #124.

Included also are 5 notebooks (1849-53) kept by George C. Dickinson, Serrell's principal assistant; and 4 notebooks (1837-63) kept by Edwin Smith.

Complementing the field notebooks are an index to the field notebooks of land surveys; and a survey book, 1845.

The index to the field notebooks of land surveys records the date of the survey; the name of the property owner; the street address or coordinates of the property or area surveyed; the number of the field notebook which contains the survey data; and the type of survey which was made (i.e., lot, house, vault, grading, sewer). The index is arranged into three sections: (1) unnumbered streets listed in alphabetically by street name; (2) avenues arranged alphabetically ("A" - "D") and then numerically (#1 - #13); (3) and numbered streets (1st - 45th). A few surveys of properties outside of New York City are filed alphabetically within the unnumbered streets section.

The survey book (1845) contains multi-colored maps and drawings of Serrell's surveys of properties in New York City owned by private persons and by the Corporation of the City of New York. The book contains an incomplete index by street name and by property owner. The book includes maps of the Eastern Post Road between 23rd and 66th Streets; maps of the Kingsbridge Road between 67th and 228th Streets; and maps of properties (showing names of owners) on the east and west sides of 5th Avenue between 42nd and 87th Streets. There is also a survey of the Atlantic Dock, Brooklyn; and Nathan Coleman's farm at Poughkeepsie (N.Y.).

B. The correspondence (1840-92), which is arranged chronologically, consists of correspondence received with a few drafts of out-going letters. The correspondence relates mainly to Serrell's maps and surveys of private properties, and of city streets and sewers. Included is some correspondence relating to the blasting at Hell Gate and Serrell's proposals for the diversion of the East River and the building of a tunnel under the English Channel. Correspondents include Croton Aqueduct Department; John M. Carrere (Oct. 21, 1889); Carrere & Hastings (May 28, 1889), George W. Da Cunha (Mar. 24., 1881); Alexander Hamilton, Jr. (Jan [1854], Mar. 25, 1854); John Jay (May 5, May 24, 1858, n.d.); and Fernando Wood (July 27, 1870, Dec. 3, Dec. 6, Dec. 9, 1873 (to Wood). Included also is a letter (Apr. 2, 1888) from Mary E. Serrell, sister of James E. Serrell; and 3 letters (Sept. 1, Oct. 2, 1856 & n.d.) from William Thornton, an Irish immigrant, who describes his personal life and economic conditions in rural Durham, New York.

The land papers (1845-92) consist of chronological file of maps and surveys, assessment lists, notes, memoranda, receipts, and annotated land auction catalogs. Included are papers relating to Booth's Theater, the Jumel Estate, and vault surveys made for the Croton Aqueduct Department.

The miscellaneous papers consist of a file of papers arranged topically. Included are papers relating to a proposed Broadway underground rail road and to a tunnel under the East River; papers relating to Serrell's court appearances, his patents, and to his service as captain of the corps of engineers of the 11th Regiment of the New York State Militia. There are also a few personal miscellaneous papers, a few cabinet portraits of unidentified persons, and clippings relating to New York City and to the development of its infrastructure including and East River bridge and tunnel, and the blasting at Hell Gate to remove obstructions in the East River.

The papers relating to Serrell's service as captain of the corps of engineers of 11th Regiment of the New York State Militia include copies of orders for meetings issued by Serrell and by the Headquarters of the 1st Division (Washington Rifles); a scrapbook containing correspondence to Serrell from Col. Homer Bostwick, regimental commander; brigade and regimental orders; a plan drawn by Serrell of Camp Washington on Staten Island containing an inventory of military stores there; and Serrell's "Engineer Drill" book. The drill book contains a roster of members of the corps of engineers; drill instructions illustrated by pen and ink sketches of military figures; copies of orders issued; a roll for drills and parades; and instructions relative to military field maneuvers, the use of the semaphore and the techniques of triangulation.

Some oversized miscellaneous papers have been filed in Series V. Oversized Maps and Papers.

Series III. Papers of Henry G. Opdycke (Containers #28-29)

The papers of Henry G. Opdycke consist of:

- A. Correspondence and Miscellaneous Papers; and
- B. Papers relating to the Automobile Club of America.

A. The correspondence (1893-1917), which is arranged chronologically, relates to the surveying and engineering work of the firm of Opdycke & Thomson, and of Henry G. Opdycke. Included are a few letters relating to the acquisition of the notes, maps and surveys of James E. Serrell.

The miscellaneous papers include miscellaneous maps, notes, surveys, receipts, and land auction prospectuses; agreements; papers relating to the Morris Park Motor Club, photographs, and a card file index of maps. Included are photographs (1912 of Astor buildings in New York City, and a photograph of Henry G. Opdycke and H. Serrell Thomson taken in their office in 1899.

B. The papers (1901-06) relating to the Automobile Club of America reflect Henry G. Opdycke's work as the Club's engineer in charge of preparations and timing for the Club's automobile races. Included are papers relating to the following races: 500 mile Endurance Contest, Aug. 1901; Brake Contest, May 1, 1902; 100 Mile Endurance Contest, New York to Bridgeport, May 30, 1902; Grant City, Staten Island, May 31, 1902; New York, Boston, Pittsfield, Newburgh, New York Race, Sept. 1903; and the Two Gallon Efficiency Contest, New York - Bridgeport and Beyond, May 5, 1906.

The papers include correspondence, engineering notes and surveys, official programs and racing rules, route maps, road directions, itineraries, and instructions for drivers. There are also printed lists of names of entrants, the type of vehicle entered, its horsepower, the name of its manufacturer and other specifications. Included are two printed volumes: *The Automobile Club of America / 1902 / Incorporated 1899* (New York, 753 Fifth Ave.); and *Reliability Contest New York to Boston and Return...Official Programme* (The Automobile Club of America, 1902). There are also papers relating to the First Annual Winter Automobile Racing Meet, Ormond - Daytona Beach, Florida, Mar. 26-28, 1903, sponsored by the American Automobile Association.

Series IV. Papers of William R. Patrick (Container #32)

The papers of William R. Patrick consist of correspondence (1928-63) and miscellaneous papers including surveying notes and memoranda relating to his practice as surveyor and civil engineer. Surveys made by William R. Patrick are filed in Series I. (New York City Land Maps and Surveys) in the following block numbers: #603 (1927), #606 (1930), #1002 (1931), #2677 (1920), #2696+ (1921), #2815+ (1923), #2820 (1923), #2873+ (1930), #2904 (1919), #2978+ (1919), #2989 (1930), #5643 (1929-30).

Series V. Oversized Maps and Papers (Containers #33-37)

The Oversized Maps and Papers consist of oversized maps and surveys arranged by block number which have been transferred from Series I; miscellaneous oversized maps and surveys by James E. Serrell, Henry G. Opdycke, and William R. Patrick; oversized broadsides (1848-81) of land auctions held in New York City; and miscellaneous oversized papers.

Included in the miscellaneous oversized papers are maps and surveys made by Henry G. Opdycke for the Automobile Club of America; an engineering drawing made by James E. Serrell depicting an unidentified mechanical device; and clippings and copies of newspapers collected by James E. Serrell. Included are copies of *The Daily Graphic*, Sept. 25, 1876; the *Evening Telegram*, Sept. 24, 1876; *The New York Herald*, Dec. 30, 1870; *The Sun*, July 9, 1870; and the *Sunday Mercury*, Apr. 10, 1864.

Shelved separately are maps and engineering drawings by James E. Serrell.

Also shelved separately is an atlas of maps of New York City copied by James E. Serrell from the original maps made by John Randel, Jr. The atlas, which contains 218 leaves of pen and ink drawings of maps embellished with water colors on parchment paper, is entitled: "Atlas of Map of the City of New York North of Houston Street Copied from Surveys by John Randel Jr., Esq. Now on File in the Street Department". The maps cover the area north of Houston Street to 219th Street and 14th Avenue. The names of owners of property appear on their respective lots [giant folio vol. in blue cloth binding].
