**Abstract:** One volume, containing a surgeon's journal kept on board U.S.S. Falmouth while cruising as flag ship of the West India Squadron from May 8, 1829 to May 10, 1830. The journal provides names of patients, ailments, and treatments, and is indexed. Benjamin Franklin Bache was surgeon, and George W. Codwise assistant surgeon, on the Falmouth during this period
