Abstract: In this account book, Virginia planter Nathaniel Lyttleton Savage made entries about business transactions between 1768 and 1785. The entries include information about African Americans (bought, sold, and hired), bonds, certificates, loans, rents, tobacco, corn, horses, and other matters, as well as Savage's statement of damages inflicted by the British forces in 1781 and a memorandum concerning the privateer Northampton
