Abstract:	The AIDS and Adolescents Network of New York was established in 1987 by a coalition of youth and health service providers concerned about the impact of the HIV/AIDS epidemic on adolescents. The organization sponsored HIV/AIDS education, prevention and service programs for young people, and promoted public policies, government funding and youth activism to end the HIV/AIDS epidemic. The records of the organization comprise administrative correspondence, board minutes, publications, program files, fundraising materials, news clippings, printed matter and photographs.
Access:	The collection is open for research, with the exception of Boxes 40, 41, 57, 58 and 59, which are closed until 2085.

Historical Note

The AIDS and Adolescents Network of New York (AANNY) was established in 1987 by a coalition of social and health service providers concerned with the impact of the HIV/AIDS epidemic on adolescents. Members of AANNY included educators, students, counselors, health care workers and policy-makers representing public and private hospitals, schools, social service agencies, city agencies and AIDS service organizations from the five boroughs of New York City. AANNY sponsored HIV/AIDS education and prevention programs for young people, and organized conferences and workshops for social service providers. The organization pressured city and state government officials to support public policies and funding to stop the spread of HIV/AIDS, and encouraged young people to participate in these lobbying efforts. AANNY advocated the inclusion of HIV/AIDS education in the New York City public school curriculum, and supported a controversial Board of Education-sponsored program to distribute condoms to students. Organizational members of AANNY included Gay Men's Health Crisis, Lesbian & Gay Community Services Center and New York Community Trust. Financial supporters included the American Foundation for AIDS Research, the Fund for the City of New York, the Rockefeller Brothers Foundation and the Ms. Foundation for Women. In addition, various AANNY activities were funded by city and state government agencies. Declining financial support forced AANNY to close its offices and public programs in the autumn of 1999.

Scope and Content Note

The AIDS and Adolescents Network of New York Records comprise administrative correspondence, board minutes, publications, training materials, program files, fundraising materials, news clippings, printed matter and photographs. The records document all areas of the organization's activities, including provision of HIV/AIDS education and services to young people, training of social service and health care workers, advocacy of government funding for HIV/AIDS prevention programs, and sponsorship of youth activism in support of HIV/AIDS services.

SERIES I. ADMINISTRATION, 1987-1999

Arranged in three subseries:

Subseries A. Network Coordinator Files

Correspondence, reports and financial records in this subseries document early activities of the AIDS and Adolescents Network of New York (AANNY). The bulk of the material is from the office of the organization's first coordinator, Catherine Lynch. Topics include the presentation of educational forums on HIV/AIDS, advocacy of government funding to support HIV/AIDS prevention programs, publication of a comprehensive guide to HIV/AIDS services offered by public and private institutions, fundraising, and staffing. The files are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Subseries B. Teri Lewis Files

Teri Lewis served as Executive Director of AANNY from 1990-1996. This subseries contains board minutes, correspondence, financial records, reports, printed materials and program files that document all areas of AANNY activity during her tenure. Topics include the presentation of educational forums on HIV/AIDS for youth and social service providers, advocacy of government funding to support HIV/AIDS prevention programs, publication of resource guides on HIV/AIDS services, fundraising and personnel issues. Also documented here is AANNY participation in the fractious public debate over the distribution of condoms in the New York City public schools. Substantial information on this subject, and related public education issues, is contained in files titled "Education Task Force," "HIV/AIDS Advisory Council," "Parental opt-out" and "Resolution #33." The subseries also includes copies of the AANNY newsletter, *The Networker*, annual meeting materials, annual reports, staff and membership meeting minutes, membership lists, organizational by-laws and mission statements. Finally, there are several boxes of news clippings and printed materials concerning HIV/AIDS and efforts to prevent its spread. The files are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Subseries A. Maggie Brennan Files

Maggie Brennan served as AANNY Executive Director from 1997-1999. The subseries contains correspondence, financial records, reports, printed materials and program files that document all areas of AANNY activity during her tenure. At this time the organization placed special emphasis on youth outreach and advocacy through sponsorship of the Young Women's Mentoring Project and the Youth Fighting for Change program. Other areas of work represented in these files include educational forums, publication of a guide to HIV/AIDS services offered by public and private institutions, fundraising and personnel issues. The files are arranged alphabetically by subject.

SERIES II. DEVELOPMENT, 1987-1999

BOXES 43-50

Records in this series document fundraising activities by AANNY staff and board members. Files are arranged alphabetically by the name of the granting institution or by subject heading, and include correspondence, grant proposals, notifications of awards, rejection letters and program progress reports. There is substantial information regarding such important AANNY supporters as the Rockefeller Brothers Fund and the Ms. Foundation for Women. Also filed here are documents pertaining to the annual AANNY awards benefit fund raising event, such as promotional materials and records of donations received from attendees.

SERIES III. OTHER ORGANIZATIONS, 1987-1999

BOXES 50-56

Filed here are brochures, newsletters, flyers, special reports and other printed materials issued by social service, health service and HIV/AIDS service organizations from across the United States. Several of these organizations, such as the New York AIDS Coalition, collaborated closely with AANNY on HIV/AIDS education and advocacy projects in New York City. The materials in this alphabetically arranged series are a good source of information on a wide variety of efforts to provide HIV/AIDS education, prevention and service programs to young people, and to promote public policies, government funding and youth activism to end the HIV/AIDS epidemic.
