The orderly book, with entries dated March 19-August 25, 1813, is largely in the handwriting of Joseph H. Hawkins, aide de camp of Brigadier General Green Clay. The correspondence dates from March 20-December 30, 1813 and consists of letters addressed to Clay relating to politics, military, and personal matters
