Abstract: Jurist and governor of Tennessee. Five letters including an 1814 item to Governor David Holmes of Mississippi discussing Andrew Jackson's promotion to Major General; a 1815 item to Governor Holmes regarding the ceremonial gift of a sword to Andrew Jackson; and a 1822 item describing, in depth, Blount's views on the role of Christianity in government.
