## De LANCEY STOW MEMORIAL COLLECTION

The De Lancey Stow Numerial Collection, (1793-1918) consists of William Sear Stow (1797-1880) and his son De Lancey Stow (1841-1925) papers, lawyers who practiced law in upstate New York. <u>Correspondence</u>, 1816-1918, are incoming letters, it covers the early period William Sear Stow became a lawyer, 1818, and after. He lived in Hudson, Chenango and finally Wayne County, village of Clyde. Included also are letters to William S. Stow from his siblings. The bulk of the letters to him are from clients. for whom he undertook lawsuits, insurance claims, collector, etc., including being representative for William S. De Zeng in connection with his glass factory in Clyde. However c. 1863, William and his son De Lancey formed a partnership. Letters c. 1863 foward are mainly clients to De Lancey some to William. Other letters indicate his political interest with the Democratic Party and a proposal to electrify a railroad system in Clyde, New York.

Land Papers, 1793-1896, filed by state consists of indentures, land deeds, surveys, articles of agreement, contracts and bonds. <u>Legal Papers</u>, c. 1816-1909, arranged according to court system includes Court of Common Pleas, 1819-47; Court of Chancery-7th Circuit, 1821-45; Supreme Court-Special Cases 1816-40; Supreme Court 1830-1909. Other legal papers are New York State-Wayne County, village of Clyde, 5t John Church records, 1856-76; Pension Papers--Service of 1812; Pension <sup>\*</sup>apers--Civil War, filed by name A-Z and miscellaneous legal papers, 1813-1903; n.d.

<u>Financial Papers</u> are <u>Accounts</u>, 1810-62, consists mainly of accounts due and paid. The <u>bound volumes</u> include personal accounts 1828; Chancery Court Register, 1843-47 (1), Cash books, 1831-1888 (4); Daybooks (2); Ledger 1866-70; Registers (5) and Pension Claims-Civil War (1). The remaining material are maps of New York State, Florida and Michigan and <u>printed material</u>.
