Abstract: E. Dutilh & Co. was a merchant company based in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and founded by Etienne Dutil (1748_3_1810). The receipt book documents the company's finances concerning trade, rent, taxes, and bills of exchange between January 25, 1786 and August 1, 1789. Of note is a passenger list for Germans traveling on the ship Dorothea
