Date: 1885-1915

Abstract: Records of the first Director of The New York Public Library. John Shaw Billings (1838-1913) served as Director of NYPL from its founding in 1895 until 1913. He helped create NYPL by combining the Astor and Lenox Libraries into a public research library and building a branch library system for three of the boroughs of New York City (Manhattan, Staten Island and the Bronx.) He also planned and oversaw the construction of the NYPL Central Building which was opened to the public in 1911.

Creator History

John Shaw Billings, the first director of The New York Public Library, was born in Switzerland County, Indiana, on April 12, 1838. He completed his B.A. degree at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, in 1857 and received his M.D. in 1860 at the Medical College of Ohio. On September 3, 1862, he married Katharine Mary Stevens of Washington, D.C. The couple had six children.

From 1862 to 1864, Billings served as a field surgeon with the U.S. Army. In December 1864, he was transferred to the Surgeon-General's office in Washington to do administrative work. He was put in charge of the Surgeon-General's Library, and, over the next thirty years, built it up into one of the world's largest and most comprehensive medical collections. In 1879, he began editing the monthly guide to medical literature, the *Index Medicus*.

Also during these years, he produced numerous articles and lectures, mostly on public hygiene and sanitation, and served as a consultant in the planning of Johns Hopkins Hospital and the hygiene laboratory at the University of Pennsylvania.

Billings was fifty-seven when he retired from the Army in October 1895. He had intended to accept the position of professor of hygiene at the University of Pennsylvania, but was persuaded to become the director of The New York Public Library by its newly-formed Board of Trustees, following the merger of the Astor and Lenox Libraries and the Tilden Foundation. In January 1896, he formally assumed the directorship of The Library, a position he held for the next seventeen years.

As Director, Billings oversaw three major projects: the integration of the holdings of the Astor and Lenox Libraries, the design and completion of the Central Building, and the consolidation of New York's free circulating libraries into a branch library system administered by The New York Public Library. His director's office papers, particularly the correspondence, reflect his active involvement in all facets of The Library's operations, from the acquisition of new materials to personnel decisions at a variety of levels.

Billings's health began to decline in 1912, and further worsened after the death of his wife that August. He died of pneumonia following surgery on March 11, 1913.

Scope and Content Note

The John Shaw Billings Records document Billings' seventeen years as the Director of The New York Public Library, from 1896 to 1913. They also include correspondence and other items from the office of Edwin H. Anderson, his former assistant director, who became Director upon Billings' death. The bulk of the collection consists of incoming and outgoing letters and internal memoranda, mostly concerning such library matters as the purchase and exchange of books and other materials, the hiring and termination of library employees, and finances. Most of the early correspondence has been lost. There are also architectural sketches and drawings, minutes of staff meetings, card files, and other materials.

Arrangement: The collection has been arranged in five series: I. Correspondence, 1895-1914; II. Central Building Files, 1885-1915; III. Order Files, 1896-1904, 1911-1915; IV. Other Materials, 1895-1913; V. New York Child Welfare Exhibit, 1910-1911.

Series I. Correspondence 1895-1914

Files of incoming and outgoing letters and memos, 1895-1914; letterbooks containing copies of outgoing correspondence, 1896-1912, and the card index to those letterbooks; and stenographic notebooks of Billings's secretary, L.D. Covert, 1908-1910. Most of the correspondence files are from 1911-1914; few of those from 1895-1910 have survived. The letters pertain mostly to the various functions of The New York Public Library; they include reference questions, inter-library loan requests, and correspondence with potential donors. Readers should note that correspondence concerning orders can be found in the letterbooks in Boxes 37-41, Subseries D, as well as in Series III. For more information, see the subseries descriptions below.

Subseries A. Early Correspondence Files 1895-1910

Letters to and from Billings and other NYPL officials, including John Cadwalader, Wilberforce Eames, John Bigelow and Edwin H. Anderson, mostly consisting of questions concerning The Library's policies and procedures. The few non-correspondence items in this subseries are mainly financial records, texts of speeches, and newspaper articles enclosed with letters.
