Abstract: The Pipe Smoker's Ephemeris, established in 1964, was an irregular quarterly journal published by Tom Dunn, an avid book and pipe collector, which brought together pipe smokers and enthusiasts from around the world. TPSE served as a forum for members of the Universal Coterie of Pipe Smokers to exchange information about pipes and tobacco. The collection consists of workups and back-ups, original copies, proofs and galleys, and original photographs and artwork pertaining to the journal, as well as to related collectors' directories, announcements, and bound editions.

Biographical Note

In 1964 Tom Dunn founded The Universal Coterie of Pipe Smokers and its publication, *The Pipe Smoker's Ephemeris* (*TPSE*). Dunn published *The Pipe Smoker's Ephemeris* from his home in Queens, New York. He worked at the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company until 1991, when he retired early in order to care for his aging parents. Active in both pipe smoking and hiking circles, Dunn remained notoriously elusive, private, and humble about his achievements. Dunn's reclusiveness only fueled his status as a cult hero in the pipe smoking community, as members exchanged embellished and often invented stories of rare "sightings."

TPSE was a quaint and folksy journal that began as a small, hand-typed newsletter in 1964. The first copy was eight pages long. By the end of the journal's forty year run in 2005, TPSE had grown to over 100 pages and was decorated with photography and artwork. The journal contained tips on where to buy and how to care for the best pipes and tobacco, pipe show coverage, and articles about Sherlock Holmes and other icons of the pipe smoking milieu. Dunn compiled, bound, and mailed every copy of TPSE by himself up until his death in 2005.

TPSE was an "irregular quarterly" journal, sometimes appearing three times per year; at other times, TPSE showed up once in 1½ years. Dunn never asked members to pay for the publication. Members who felt inclined, and many did, could contribute a donation, a "pittance" as Dunn called it, to help defray printing and postage costs. Members were encouraged to write to Dunn with tips, articles, clippings, and photographs of their pipes. Letters and stories from the members made up the bulk of TPSE's contents. Each issue contained a list of new members and their contact information, encouraging correspondence between members worldwide.

At the time of the last printing of *TPSE*, the journal reached over 3,000 people around the world. During its run, Dunn produced two bound volumes of the collected *TPSE*, as well as 8 editions of the Collectors Directory, which was published roughly every four years and listed members' collecting interests.

Scope and Content Note

The Pipe Smoker's Ephemeris papers consist of the original work-ups and back-ups for *TPSE*, containing tobacco-related clippings from newspapers and magazines, original photographs and artwork submitted by members, index drafts, hand-written lists of gifts received from members, receipts and correspondence from printers, rare book and antique dealers' catalogs, drafts of individual articles and creative submissions, business cards, and CD-ROMs. While some of this material found its way into *TPSE*, much remains as backlog, providing useful context for each issue.

The papers also include originals, working copies, and proofs of *TPSE* and all eight editions of the Collectors Directory. Also included are original proofs and back-ups for Book I and Book II of the bound edition of *TPSE*.

Arrangement Note

Tom Dunn kept intact records and filed *The Pipe Smoker's Ephemeris* in rough chronological order by year, with records interspersed for the Collectors Directory and Book I and II. To preserve Dunn's original filing system, this order was not changed.

Boxes two and seven are filed in legal folders. Box eight contains two oversize original cover art designs, which rest flat on top.
