Abstract: These audio tapes were collected by Teiji It_ and consist of many of his musical compositions, performances, interviews, and lectures. Music tapes consist primarily of works for the theater, but additionally there are several major dance and film compositions. Most of the works are not attributed to any specific date, but several film score recordings are known to have been created in the early 1950's (earliest in 1952). The span of dates assigned by the composer to certain works is 1962 - 1982.

Creator History

Teiji Ito was a Tokyo-born composer who resided in New York City. His compositional style reflects Japanese, African, and American influences. Ito is known especially for his theater, dance and film music. A percussion performer, he was particularly interested in the use of percussion instruments in various cultures.

Ito composed music for some of the experimental films of his first wife Maya Deren, who died in 1961. Much of his dance and theater music was composed for productions by the *Open Eye Company* (theatrical troupe) and at the *Theater of the Open Eye* in New York City.

Custodial History

The collection was donated by Mrs. Teiji Ito to the Music Division, The New York Public Library for the Performing Arts. All sound recordings were separated and allocated to The Rodgers and Hammerstein Archives of Recorded Sound in 1987.

Scope and Content Note

These audio tapes were collected by Teiji Ito and consist of many of his musical compositions, performances, interviews, and lectures. The music tapes consist primarily of works for the theater, in addition to several major dance and film compositions. Most of the works are not attributed to any specific date. The span of dates to works to which a date has been assigned by the composer is 1962 - 1982.
