INTRODUCTION

The Ilka Chase Collection was donated to The New York Public Library, Billy Rose Theatre Collection in July of 1981 by her third husband Dr. Norton S. Brown. Overall the papers and photographs were received in good condition, although the scrapbooks and fragile items such as tintypes and paintings on ivory and ceramics were removed for conservation. Upon examination of the material it was found that the papers actually constituted two separate, although related, collections. The papers contained material related to the career of Edna Woolman Chase, Ilka Chase's mother, and her personal correspondence. For this reason, there will be two biographies and there is a separate series in which the Edna Woolman Chase Collection is kept intact. The material has been arranged into nine series measuring 13 linear feet.

BIOGRAPHIES

Ilka Chase, actress and author, was born in New York on April 8. According to <u>Who's Who in the Theatre</u>, she was born in 1905, but she disputed this date claiming that she was actually younger. Her mother was Edna Woolman Chase, editor-in-chief of <u>Vogue</u> magazine from 1914 to 1952. She began her stage career with the Stuart Walker stock company and after a season she moved over to the company of actor-manager Henry Miller with whom she appeared in "The Red Falcon" and "Embers." In 1926 she married and divorced actor Louis Calhern and went to Hollywood.

On Broadway she did DAYS WITHOUT END by Eugene O'Neill, FORSAKING ALL OTHERS, WHILE PARENTS SLEEP, ON TO FORTUNE, CO-RESPONDENT UNKNOWN, and two musicals--REVENGE WITH MUSIC and KEEP OFF THE GRASS. She also played in the stage version of her own IN BED WE CRY. She is also remembered for her role as Sylvia Fowler in the stage version of Clare Boothe Luce's THE WOMEN. She left the stage in 1944 but made a comeback in 1966, appearing as the mother-in-law in Neil Simon's BAREFOOT IN THE PARK. Her last stage appearance was in PRESENT LAUGHTER by Noel Coward at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. in 1975. Her films included FAST AND LOOSE, ONCE A SINNER, THE ANIMAL KINGDOM, THE FLORADORA GIRL, and NOW VOYAGER. Her last film was THE BIG KNIFE.

She was also a radio and television personality, playwright, writer, New York panelist and highly regarded wit. Her works included <u>Past Imperfect</u>; <u>Always</u> <u>In Vogue</u>, a history of the magazine that she co-wrote with her mother; and <u>In Bed We Cry</u>. She wrote many books and articles on travel, and had a syndicated newspaper column. She also conducted a radio program, "Luncheon at the Waldorf."

After her divorce from Calhern she married and divorced radio ad agency executive William B. Murray, a former head of the radio department of the William Morris Agency. In 1945 she married Dr. Norton S. Brown. She died in 1977. Edna Woolman Chase was born in 1877 in Asbury Park, New Jersey. In 1895 she joined the staff of <u>Vogue</u> magazine which was then in its third year. From addressing envelopes she progressed upward in the art and editorial departments. In 1909 Conde Nast bought the struggling magazine and in 1911 he made her managing director. She was editor-in-chief of the magazine from 1914 until she resigned in 1952. She died in 1957.

- Series 9. Scrapbooks

The Ilka Chase Collection measures 13 linear feet and consists of correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings, scripts, scrapbooks, and other material related to the career of Ilka Chase. There is also considerable material related to the career of her mother Edna Woolman Chase and <u>Vogue</u> magazine. The collection has many strengths. There is a tremendous amount of personal correspondence, especially between Ilka Chase and her mother. The collection also contains the entire run of scripts from a radio program hosted by Ilka Chase from January 1951 to October 1951 and a complete run of articles for a syndicated newspaper column from 1955 to 1964. The photograph collection contains photos of Ilka Chase both in her professional career and private life, Edna Woolman Chase, and other celebrities including Mr. and Mrs. Eugene O'Neill.

Researchers interested in the Edna Woolman Chase material will find the notes about the 1937 edition of <u>Vogue</u> (Box 28,076 Folder 3) useful. The Christmas cards designed by Claire Avery (Box 28,090 Folder 4) are also of interest. Another interesting item from the history of <u>Vogue</u> is a photograph with caption of the fasion do's and don'ts (Box 28,091 Folder 10). Of interest to researchers examining the life of Edna Woolman Chase or the life of Ilka Chase is the article about how Edna Woolman Chase balanced her career at <u>Vogue</u> magazine with mothering Ilka Chase (Box 28,090, Folder 3).
