Introduction

The Luther Adler Collection was donated to The Billy Rose Theatre Collection, The New York Public Library, December 1986, by Mr. Adler's niece Lulla Adler Rosenfeld.

The material arrived in good condition but in no particular order. It has been arranged alphabetically within individual series. Duplicates have been removed from the collection.

Arrangement

The collection is organized alphabetically, cataloged individually by correspondent and subject, and is comprised of the following series:

- I. Correspondence 1919-1983
- II. Productions 1918-1970
- III. Group Theatre 1931-1940
- IV. Programs and clippings 1915-1972
- V. Personal and Professional Photographs [1890]-1984

Biographical Note

Luther Adler was born May 4, 1903 in New York City. His parents, Jacob P. and Sarah Adler, were stars of the Yiddish Theatre. Luther joined his parents, brothers and sisters on the stage when he was 5 years old.

He was married in 1938 to Sylvia Sidney (marriage dissolved 1947). They had a son in 1940, Jacob Luther (Jody), who died in 1985. Mr. Adler married Julia Hadley Roche in 1959. She died in 1986.

Mr. Adler was a founding member of the Group Theatre and appeared in many of their productions.

Through the years Mr. Adler appeared in over 50 productions on Broadway, in stock and on tour. His most celebrated performances were in *A Flag is Born, Golden Boy, Awake and Sing, The Passion of Joseph D.* and *Fiddler on the Roof.* He also directed productions of *Jane Eyre, Angel Street* and *A View from the Bridge.*

Mr. Adler made his film debut in 1937 and appeared in over 25 films, notably *Cornered*, *D.O.A., The Last Angry Man, Cast a Giant Shadow, The Brotherhood* and *Voyage of the Damned*. He also appeared in over 25 productions on television. Mr. Adler died December 8, 1984.

Scope and Content Note

The Luther Adler papers contains clippings, contracts, correspondence, photographs, programs, scripts and other material. It measures 2 linear feet and is stored in 5 boxes.

The material documents Mr. Adler's career as star of stage, screen and television. It includes correspondence about Mr. Adler's problems with blacklisting (box 1, folder #3). His involvement with the Group Theatre (box 4) also appears throughout the collection. The material includes information about his family both on and off the stage.
