Abstract: The collection is almost entirely bound promptbooks, annotated with notes and cues by Prentice, for the plays he produced. The extensive handwritten staging directions as well as many loose lighting and property plots, cast lists and set design diagrams provide substantial documentation of these productions of the regional British theater in this period (1920s-1950s). There are also some autobiographical writings, notes and drafts for speeches he gave, a small amount of correspondence, mostly with playwrights, photographs from unidentified productions and some photographs of Prentice with colleagues.

Creator History

Herbert M. Prentice, British producer, director and designer staged hundreds of plays during his career including many first productions as well as popular revivals. His focus was on well known playwrights of his time including James Bridie, Noel Coward, St. John G. Ervine, Ian Hay, Frederick Lonsdale, W. Somerset Maugham, A.A. Milne, Eugene O'Neill, J. B. Priestley, George Bernard Shaw, and Oscar Wilde.

His first production was *The Silver Box* at the Little Repertory Theatre in Sheffield in 1918. He formed the Sheffield Repertory Company and directed plays there for seven years. He was then with the Festival Theatre, Cambridge and the Repertory Theatre, Northampton before being hired as producer by Sir Barry Jackson for the Birmingham Repertory Theatre in 1932. He was at the Birmingham until 1940 and staged many first productions there including *The Adding Machine, The Brontes of Haworth Parsonage* and *1066 and All That.* His first London production was *Once in a Lifetime* in 1933. During this period he also produced plays at the Malvern Festivals (1934-1937) including *Saint Joan* with Wendy Hiller on the occasion of George Bernard Shaw's 80th birthday.

In the 1940s and 1950s Prentice staged plays at the Sheffield, Southport Repertory Theatre, Stratfordon-Avon, Birmingham, the Civic Theatre at Chesterfield and the Pitlochry Festival. Prior to his tenure at the Birmingham Repertory Theatre, Prentice designed most of the settings for his productions. He also wrote a few of the stage adaptations he produced, including one for *Alice in Wonderland*.

Custodial History

The Herbert M. Prentice Papers were purchased from B.F. Stevens and Brown, Ltd. of London in August 1964.

Scope and Content Note

The collection is almost entirely bound promptbooks annotated with notes and cues by Prentice for the plays he produced. The extensive handwritten staging directions on the scripts as well as the many loose lighting and property plots, cast lists, and set design diagrams provide substantial documentation of these productions of the regional British theater in this period (1920s-1950s). There are also some autobiographical writings, notes and drafts for speeches he gave, a small amount of correspondence mostly with the playwrights, photographs from unidentified productions and some photographs of Prentice with colleagues.

Container List

Series I: Correspondence and other papers 1935-1960 (5 folders)

This series contains autobiographical material, mostly handwritten manuscripts and notes by Prentice on his career in the theater. His writings are on loose pages and in two notebooks, one dated 1960. Includes notes and drafts for speeches, notes taken during a rehearsal and correspondence with the playwright Ralph de Pomerai discussing his plays.

b. 1 f. 1 Papers / Herbert M. Prentice ca. 1935 (1 folder)

Typescript by Prentice titled "His Crime Sheet" is 4 pages of autobiographical writing on his career as a theatrical producer, director and designer.

b. 1 f. 2 Papers / Herbert M. Prentice (1 folder)

One notebook [n.d.] contains an unfinished memoir by the producer Herbert M. Prentice on his life and career in the theater. It is handwritten in pencil and ink on lined paper and has a blue paper cover tied on with string.

b. 1 f. 3 Papers / Herbert M. Prentice (1 folder)

Consists of notes and drafts of speeches handwritten in ink on lined paper by the producer Herbert M. Prentice. The pages are loose with various numberings.

b. 1 f. 4 Papers / Herbert M. Prentice November 18, 1960 (1 folder)

Spiral notebook contains notes for speeches by the producer Herbert M. Prentice, handwritten in ink on lined paper, and notes taken in pencil while watching a rehearsal.

Pomerai, Ralph de

Correspondence consists mostly of letters from playwright Pomerai to Herbert Prentice when the latter was director of the Pitlochry Festival. Also includes a few notes by Prentice on Pomerai's script, Strange Adventure.

Series II: Promptbooks and other production files 1922-1954 (75 boxes)

This series makes up the bulk of the collection because related papers such as correspondence, set designs, lighting and property plots and cast lists, have been kept with the play to which they pertain. It is arranged alphabetically by playwright. Most of the promptbooks are bound volumes consisting of the typed, usually published, pages of the scripts unbound and then pasted into larger, blank volumes, allowing ample room for Prentice's extensive notations. Some contain photographs and cast lists from original (pre-Prentice) productions. A few of these bound volumes contain two different plays. These are necessarily arranged under only one playwright with the other given an added entry for retrieval. Many of the volumes have a number pasted on the front which undoubtedly was relevant to Prentice. However, since not all volumes were numbered, this was not the system chosen for arrangement.
