## **Creator History**

American actress on stage, screen and television, Dolores Sutton was born in New York City in 1927 and was a philosophy major at New York University before co-authoring a script for NBC-TV and winning the lead. She had an active career as a performer, primarily on the stage and on television, and was also an occasional playwright.

Collection is mostly scripts reflecting the work of Dolores Sutton as both an actor and playwright. It also includes photos and clippings and a small amount of correspondence, contracts and programs.

Mostly scripts; also clippings, photos, programs, correspondence and contracts. Includes Sutton's work as a playwright as well as an actor. She often starred in the pieces she wrote.

Dolores Sutton starred with Farley Granger at the National Repertory Theatre in production directed by Eva Le Gallienne who chose Sutton to play Julie, the role she had created. Also includes a telegram to Sutton.
