Biographical note

Sweet Kitty Bellairs by David Belasco based on Agnes and Egerton Castle's book *The Bath Comed,* opened at the Belasco Theatre, New York City, Dec. 9 1903, and starred Henrietta Crosman. The play ran for 206 performances.

Scope and content note

The collection includes original costume designs, as well as a small number of textual materials, such as property lists and plots, by Percy Anderson for the play *Sweet Kitty Bellairs* by David Belasco, based on Agnes and Egerton Castle's book *The Bath Comedy* produced at the Belasco Theatre New York City, 1903.

A number of the costume designs are painted on wood. There are a few printed items, such as plates illustrating military costumes and a page from a program. The unsigned painting of Henrietta Crosman as the title character may also be by Percy Anderson.
