Abstract: The Jonathan Chappell bibliography cards on Shakespeare productions consist of index cards documenting productions from the 19th century to the 1970s, primarily in North America and Europe but also in South America, Asia, and Africa. The bibliographic references are not always complete: many of the publication titles are represented only by initials, and the collection does not include a key. Cards may include production information such as city, year, director, and lead actors. The majority of the cards are arranged alphabetically by title, and afterwards alphabetically by country of production; however, some cards are unsorted.
