Abstract: Wayne F. Maxwell (1939-2000) was an actor, director and playwright who performed on Broadway, Off-Broadway, and in regional theaters. Occasionally, he appeared on commercial television, and film. The collection, dating from the 1940s to 2005, mostly holds scripts. Other material includes: photographs, scrapbooks, theater programs, correspondence, and audio recordings.

Creator History

Wayne F. Maxwell (1939-2000) was as an actor, director and playwright. Maxwell worked mainly in theater appearing on Broadway, Off-Broadway, in and regional theaters. Occasionally, he worked in

television and film.

Maxwell's interest in theater began in his hometown of Tulsa, Oklahoma which would lead him to pursue a career as a professional actor. During his career, Maxwell sometimes collaborated with his partner M. David Samples, a stage director. During the late 1950s, they worked in the regional theaters of Hudson Valley, New York.

Other collaboration followed: including on the play The Beheading written by Thomas (Catherine) Muschamp, and Ruffles First Lay written by Maxwell. He also wrote two children's books that were published posthumously. Maxwell died in Los Angeles, California in 2000.

Custodial History

The collection was maintained by M. David Samples. The Wayne F. Maxwell papers were separated from the M. David Samples papers in 2014.

Scope and Content Note

The Wayne F. Maxwell papers, 1940s-2005, document his performing arts career mostly on Broadway, Off-Broadway and in regional theaters. Scripts comprise the bulk of the collection with several written by him.

This collection mostly reflects how Maxwell assiduously documented his career. There are four scrapbooks of photographs, programs, and reviews of Maxwell's performances from his middle school years to his time as a professional actor. The remainder of the collection is printed matter, some correspondence (mostly congratulatory), commercial photographs from plays, and two juvenile books.
