Tomlinson, and Philip Tomlinson. There are letters to Morley from Walter De la Mare, T. S. Eliot, Robert Giroux, Lewis Mumford, Ezra Pound, Herbert Read, Henry Tomlinson, Philip Tomlinson, Arthur Wheen, and others, dating from 1921 to 1980.
